

3.14 THROWDOWN/PI DAY CHALLENGE OFFICIAL RULES ("OFFICIAL RULES")

The "The Actuarial Foundation's 3.14 Throwdown/Pi Day Challenge" (the "Challenge") is sponsored by The Actuarial Foundation, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation (the "Sponsor"). The Challenge is governed by these Official Rules. By participating in the Challenge, each individual entering the Challenge (each referred to herein as an "Entrant") agrees to abide by these Official Rules, including all eligibility requirements, and understands that the results of the Challenge, as determined by the Sponsor and its agents, are final in all respects. The Challenge is subject to all federal, state, and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited by law.

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** This Challenge is open only to legal residents of the United States (not including residents of Florida and New York). Only individuals who are at least eighteen (18) years of age or older (except, in the case of legal residents of certain states where the legal age of majority is greater than eighteen (18) years of age, such legal age of majority) at the time of entry. Employees, officers, and directors (including immediate family members (spouse, parent, child, sibling, and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) and members of the same household, whether or not related) of the Sponsor and any and all companies associated with the Challenge are not eligible to participate or win the Prizes (as defined below). Eligibility is also contingent upon compliance with these Official Rules and fulfilling all requirements set forth herein. The Challenge is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations. Void in Florida, New York and where prohibited or restricted by law, rule, or regulation. Participants residing in areas in which the Challenge is void may participate in the Challenge but not win the prize.

2. **HOW TO ENTER:** There is no entry fee, and no purchase is necessary to enter or win this Challenge. The Challenge begins at 12:00 AM on February 18, 2026 and ends at 11:59 P.M. CST on March 14, 2026 ("Submission Period").

a. Signing up to receive emails from Sponsor. By doing so you agree to receive these emails. You can revoke your consent by clicking Unsubscribe at any time.

b. **Additional Entries.**

- Donations. Entrants who make a charitable donation to Sponsor of between \$31 and \$313 will receive one (1) additional entry; five (5) additional entries for donating between \$314 and \$3,140; and ten (10) additional entries for donating \$3,141 or more.

- **Reciting Pi, Following/Sharing, Tagging/Hashtag.** Entrants who participate electronically by completing the following steps and reciting ten (10) or more digits of Pi from memory will receive one (1) additional entry:

- Following @actuarialfoundation on Instagram or LinkedIn; **and**
- Sharing the Challenge post; **and**
- Submitting a video recitation of the Entrant reciting as many digits of Pi **from memory** (no cheat sheets or notes may be used) as they are able (the "Submission") **and** use the hashtag #TAFPiDay2026 in the caption for the video recitation. **Entrants should recite as many digits of Pi as possible in their video Submission. All Submissions must be received during the Submission Period.**

No more than twelve (12) total entries per person during the Submission Period. Sponsor reserves the right to extend or shorten the Challenge at its sole discretion.

The Entrant who correctly recites the greatest number of digits of Pi from **memory** during the Challenge will be recognized as the Pi Day Challenge Champion and be eligible to receive the Champion Prize (described below). If Sponsor determines that an Entrant used notes or other memory aids during their recitation of Pi, such Entrant will be disqualified from the Challenge.

c. **Alternate Method of Entry (AMOE).** You may enter the Challenge by hand-printing your full name; address; city; state; zip code; cell, day and/or evening telephone numbers (including area codes); date of birth and e-mail address on an 8"x10" piece of paper and mailing it in a sealed envelope with proper postage affixed to: The Actuarial Foundation, 869 E. Schaumburg Road, #321, Schaumburg, IL 60194-3654. All AMOE must be received on or before the close of the Submission Period.

3. **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:** Entries or Submissions not in compliance with the submission requirements outlined in these Official Rules (as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion) may not be considered. Submissions and Entries may not include profanity, obscenity or otherwise incorporate inappropriate themes or activities. Submissions and Entries may not include, depict, or promote vandalism or property damage. Submissions or Entries found, in Sponsor's sole discretion, to be inappropriate, in poor taste, or to violate the Sponsor's Bylaws or policies will be disqualified. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, unreadable, unqualified, or incomplete Submissions/Entries, or Submissions/Entries not received for any reason. Receipt of Submissions/Entries will not be acknowledged.

4. **WINNER SELECTION:**

a. **Challenge Winners.** On or about March 14, 2026 (the close of the Promotional Period), Sponsor will select up to three (3) winners at random from amongst all Entrants as detailed below ("Preliminary Winners"). Subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with the terms of these Official Rules, these Preliminary Winners will be declared the official winners of the Challenge (the "Winners") and will receive the prize described below. The decisions of Sponsor are final and binding for all matters relating to the Challenge. **Odds of winning depend on the total number of Entrants.**

b. **Pi Day Challenge Champion.** The Entrant who correctly recites the greatest number of digits of Pi from **memory** in their video Submission will be recognized as the Pi Day Challenge Champion and will receive the Champion Prize described below (subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with the terms of these Official Rules). The decisions of Sponsor are final and binding for all matters relating to the selection of the Pi Day Challenge Champion. Sponsor reserves the right to require the Entrant to recite Pi from memory during a live zoom for verification purposes. In the event of a tie between two or more entrants, the winner will be selected randomly by Sponsor from amongst such entrants. There will be only one (1) Pi Day Challenge Champion.

c. Entries and/or Submissions that do not comply with these Official Rules are subject to disqualification. The Sponsor's decision regarding all matters of the Challenge, including, without limitation, whether an Entrant or Submission is qualified, will be final and binding and no discussions will be entered into with respect thereto.

5. **PRIZE DESCRIPTION:**

a. Three (3) Preliminary Winners will be selected to win a pie a quarter for one (1) year (4 pies total) (estimated retail value: \$252 USD) (3 winners total).

b. The Entrant who correctly recites the greatest number of digits of Pi from memory in their submission winner will (i) be recognized as the Pi Day Challenge Champion on TAF social media; and (ii) receive one (1) pie a month for one (1) year (12 pies total) (est. retail value \$696 USD) (1 winner total).

Total estimated retail value of all Prizes \$1,452.

Sponsor is not responsible for inaccurate Prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this Challenge. No cash alternative to any of the Prizes will be offered. Prizes are not transferable. The Prizes are subject to availability and the Sponsor reserves the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice. Sponsor will notify the winners when and where their Prize can be collected. ALL TAXES ARE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE WINNERS. Prizes are awarded without warranty, express or implied, of any kind. The winners name, image, likeness and Submission may be included in Sponsor's publications and posted on its website, Instagram, LinkedIn and other social media accounts.

6. WINNER NOTIFICATION: Winners will be notified within 7 days after the end of the Submission Period via Instagram or LinkedIn DM and/or email. Inability to contact a winner may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner. If a winner cannot be contacted or does not claim their Prize within 7 days of notification or is not qualified to win, the Sponsor reserves the right to withdraw the Prize from the winner and choose a replacement winner.

7. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

a. Entrants entering a Submission into the Challenge warrant that they have permission to do so from all those tagged in the Submission, and Entrants relieve Sponsor and its respective subsidiaries and affiliates, of all liability.

b. As a condition of receiving the Prize, the winner will be required to execute and return a Certificate of Eligibility, Consent and General Release form within 7 days of notification. Noncompliance within this time period may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner.

c. No transfer, assignment, or substitution of the Prize permitted, except Sponsor reserves the right to substitute Prize (or prize components) for an item of equal or greater value at Sponsor's sole discretion.

d. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply. Entrants agree to be bound by the terms of these Official Rules and by the decisions of Sponsor, which are final and binding on all matters pertaining to this Challenge.

e. By entering and/or accepting the Prize, Entrants and all winners agree to hold and indemnify Sponsor, and its respective subsidiaries and affiliates, promotional partners, directors, officers, agents, attorneys, and employees harmless for liability, damages, or claims for injury or loss to any person or property, relating to, in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, participation in this Challenge, the acceptance and/or subsequent use or misuse or condition of the Prizes awarded, or any claims including but not limited to claims based on publicity rights, defamation, invasion of privacy, or copyright infringement. False or deceptive entries or acts will render the Entrant ineligible. Sponsor, in its sole discretion, reserves the immediate and unrestricted right to disqualify any Entrant or any Prize winner, if either commits or has committed any act or has been involved or becomes involved in any situation or occurrence which the Sponsor deems likely to subject the Sponsor, Entrant, or winner to ridicule, scandal, or contempt or which reflects unfavorably upon the Sponsor in any way. If such information is discovered by Sponsor after a winner has received notice of winning and before the Prize is awarded, Sponsor may rescind the Prize in its entirety. If a portion of the Prize has already been awarded, Sponsor may withdraw the remainder of the Prize that has been fulfilled. Decisions of the Sponsor are final and binding in all matters related to this paragraph. Sponsor is not responsible for any typographical or other error in the printing of the offer, administration of the Challenge, or in the announcement of the Prize.

8. NOT ENDORSED BY INSTAGRAM OR LINKEDIN: By participating in this Challenge, Entrant acknowledges that this Challenge is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by, or associated with Instagram or LinkedIn and releases Instagram and LinkedIn from any and all liability arising from or related to this Challenge. The information you are providing for this Challenge is being provided to the Sponsor and not to Instagram or LinkedIn and will be used to notify you if you have won, and to inform you about special offers from the Sponsor and/or its trusted partners, affiliates, exhibitors, and sponsors.

9. CONDUCT: All Entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules. Sponsor, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person they find to be tampering with the entry process or operation of the Challenge website or that they find has otherwise violated these rules.

10. LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY: Sponsor is not responsible for lost or late Submissions nor for electronic-transmission errors resulting in omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operations or transmission, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to or alterations of entry materials, or for technical, network, telephone-equipment, electronic, computer, hardware, or software malfunctions or limitations of any kind, or inaccurate transmissions of or failure to receive entry information by Sponsor or presenter on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website or any combination thereof. If for any reason the Internet portion of the program is not capable of running as planned, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes that corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this Challenge, the Sponsor reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process and to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the Challenge. Sponsor reserves the right to select a winner from eligible entries received as of the termination date. CAUTION: Any attempt by an Entrant to deliberately damage any website, Sponsor's intranet or undermine the legitimate operation of the Challenge is a violation of criminal and civil laws and should such an attempt be made, Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages from any such Entrant to the fullest extent of the law. If there is a dispute as to the identity of the Entrant, the Prize will be awarded to the authorized account holder of the e-mail address. The "authorized account holder" is defined as the natural person to whom the e-mail address is assigned.

11. PUBLICITY. Except where prohibited by law, Entry into the Challenge constitutes an Entrant's express consent to be contacted by the Sponsor by telephone, e-mail, and/or postal mail for promotional and other purposes. A Winner, by acceptance of their respective Prize, grants to Sponsor the right to publicize and distribute such Winner's Submission, name, likeness, photograph, voice, statements, opinion, hometown and state, and/or other likeness and Prize information for promotional, fundraising, advertising, trade, and/or any other purposes in any media or format now known or hereafter devised, throughout the world, in perpetuity, without limitation, including on social media websites, without further compensation, payment, consideration, permission or notification, unless prohibited by law.

12. GOVERNING LAW: This Challenge is governed by the laws of the State of Illinois, without regard to principles of conflict of laws. All cases and claims pertaining to this Challenge must be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction in Cook County, Illinois, without recourse to class-action suits. Further, in any such dispute, under no circumstances will Entrants be permitted to obtain awards for, and hereby waive all rights to claim, punitive, incidental, or consequential damages, including attorneys' fees, other than participant's actual out-of-pocket expenses (e.g., costs associated with Entry), and participant further waives all rights to have damages multiplied or increased.

13. ENTRANT'S PERSONAL INFORMATION. Sponsor will be collecting personal information about Entrants, in accordance with its privacy policy, available at <https://www.actuarialfoundation.org/privacy-policy/> ("Sponsor Privacy Policy"). By participating in the Challenge, participants hereby acknowledge that they have read and agree to the Sponsor Privacy Policy and the collection and usage of their personal information. Notwithstanding any provision of the Sponsor Privacy Policy, Entrants' information may be shared with the Sponsor's marketing affiliates, sponsors and exhibitors and may be used for marketing purposes and/or to send follow-up communications to each Entrant relating to the Sponsor's business. Participation in this Challenge constitutes your full and complete agreement to receive all such

communications, subject to receipt of any opt-out requests related to e-mail communications.

14. PROMOTION AND SPONSOR. Participation in the Challenge constitutes an Entrant's full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules. The Sponsor is The Actuarial Foundation, 869 E. Schaumburg Road, #321, Schaumburg, IL 60194-3654.. All decisions related to, as well as all interpretation of these Official Rules, will be made by the Sponsor and will be final and binding.

15. SEVERABILITY: If any provision of these Official Rules is found to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction or appointed arbitrator, such determination shall in no way affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision herein.
